To whom it may concern:

The TechTools DigiView series logic analyzers are not capable of storing any captured data once power is removed. All data captures are stored in internal SRAM until transferred to the PC for analysis and local storage. Once power to the analyzer is removed, the SRAM contents will be lost.

The DV3400 and DV3500 models use an external power supply. When that power supply is disconnected from the analyzer or the analyzer's power switch is set to the OFF position, all power is removed from the SRAM causing it to loose its contents.

All other DigiView models (DV1-100, DV3100, DV3200, DV3109, DV3209, DV3409, DV509, and DV518) are powered from the USB cable. When the USB cable is disconnected from the analyzer, all power is removed from the SRAM causing it to loose its contents.
